# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PORT OF EPHRATA COMMISSIONERS January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016

The Board of Commissioners for the Port District No. 9 of Grant County met in regular session on January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016 in the Port conference room. Commissioner Karen Moore called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m.

**BUILDING 1 & 2 WALKTHROUGH:** All those present at the meeting took a walkthrough of the buildings to become familiar with and discuss potential rental options.
